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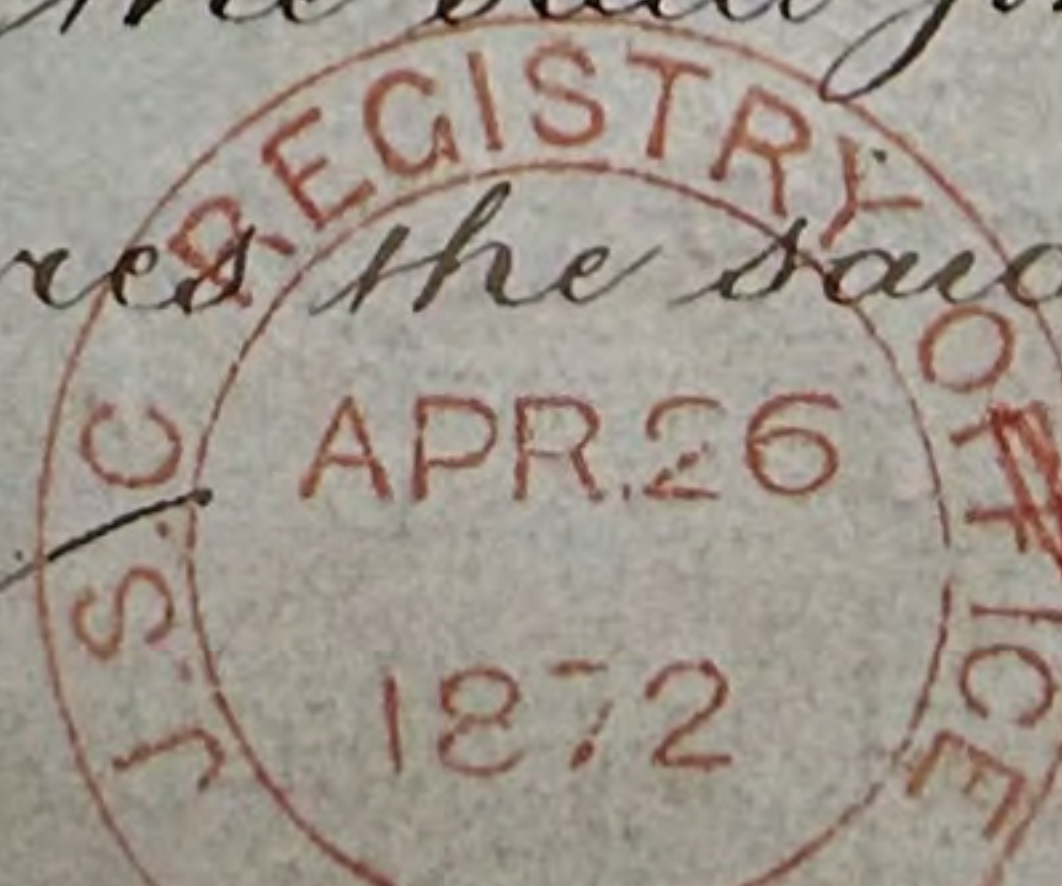

porter of or to Sixty of such shares and the said Robert William Staniland of or to Sixty of such shares and the said parties hereto are also proposed and as between themselves in the like shares and proportions of a certain Leasehold estate in East Malling aforesaid and the estimated value of the said Freehold and Leasehold premises including the cost of the erection thereon of divers expensive kilns and other buildings and also of fixed machinery is the sum of One hundred and thirteen thousand four hundred and thirty three Pounds six shillings and eight pence which is in fact the cost price of the purchase of the said premises and of the erection of the said kilns buildings and conveniences

And whereas on the first day of January One thousand eight hundred and seventy two the said parties hereto formed themselves into and were duly registered as a limited Company under the name of "The Burham Brick Lime and Cement Company Limited" and by the Memorandum of Association of the said Company the objects for which the said Company was established were to acquire amongst other things the said Freehold and Leasehold premises and to carry on the business therein as mentioned and the capital of the Company was fixed at Two hundred thousand pounds divided into Two thousand shares of One hundred pounds each and the Subscribers to the said Memorandum of Association and the number of shares for which they respectively subscribed were as follows namely the said Meaburn Staniland in the number of Five hundred and twenty eight shares the said

William Welster and George Inceed each in the number of Two hundred and eighty nine shares the said John Ward and William Varney each in the number of Eighty seven shares and the said William Porter and Robert William Staniland each in the number of Sixty shares the proportions in which the said parties hereto so subscribed for the said Shares in the said Company being the same as the proportions in which they are so as hereinbefore recited seized of or entitled to the said Freehold and leasehold hereditaments

And whereas the said Limited Company at present consists exclusively of the said parties hereto as such subscribers to the said Memorandum of Association as aforesaid there being no other Shareholder in the said Company and no allotment of or other issue of shares in the said Company having yet been made

And whereas it was part of the arrangement under which the said Limited Company was constituted that the said Freehold and Leasehold premises should be taken over by the said Company at the aforesaid price of One hundred and thirteen thousand four hundred and thirty three Pounds six Shillings and eight Pence and that the shares so as aforesaid subscribed for by the said parties hereto should be issued to them as shares each with Fifty of Pounds fourteen Shillings and four pence paid thereon the respective aggregate amounts of the sums so to be treated as paid upon the shares of each of the said respective subscribers to the said Memorandum of Association being equivalent to the respective amounts in which they would respectively be entitled to the said purchase money if the same were paid in cash

Now it is hereby agreed between and by the
said parties hereto that the shares in the said limited
company so as aforesaid subscribed for by the said
parties hereto respectively shall be issued to them
respectively as shares each with Fifty of Pounds
fourteen Shillings and four pence paid thereon leaving
the sum of Forty three Pounds five Shillings and
eight pence only payable by them respectively upon
each of their said Shares and that the said parties
hereto shall forthwith convey to and effectually vest
in the said company and their assigns all the said
Freehold and Leasehold premises and shall in the
meantime stand seized and possessed of the same
premises respectively upon trust for the same Company
